Eligibility: State Governments, Counties, Cities, Towns, Villages and Private Non-Profit Groups. All eligible must already be in existence, non-profits must have a current charities registration with the NYS Department of State. All must have a Federal ID number.

Type of Program and Special Restrictions: Subject to mandated State and Federal requirements. Funds must be used specifically for services to victims of crime.

Action Required to Receive Aid: Competitive application for aid required.

Flow of Funds: Federal to State to Local (Pass-through), State to Local. Monies are provided in advance of expenditures by the local government.
