## Executive Year-to-Year Change

The Judiciary's All Funds appropriation request is \$2,078,096,433, an increase of \$126,188,855, or 6.5 percent over SFY 2004-05.

## Article VII

The Assembly accepts the Executive's proposal to provide quarterly, rather than annual payments to the Office of Court Administration (OCA) Indigent Legal Services.

The Assembly rejects the Executive's proposal to allow tort action awards against municipalities and the State to be offset by the expectation of the receipt of future collateral source payments.

The Assembly rejects the Executive's proposal to mandate that claims against certain public corporations be brought exclusively in the Court of Claims.

The Assembly rejects a provision that would allow for business records to be presented as evidence in grand jury proceedings via affidavit.
