


## Assemblyman Brian Curran is fighting for Rockville Centre and our community.

Over the last four years, we have:

- Fought for record levels of school aid for Rockville Centre schools, including an increase of \$2,253,758 over the past 3 years for RVC public schools, and significantly increased state aid to non-public and private schools like St. Agnes each year for three years;
- Secured \$24,965 in library aid for the Rockville Centre Public Library over 4 years;
- Honored veterans and women of distinction from the Rockville Centre community;
- Sponsored an Easter Basket Program for kids at Rosa Lee School;
- Shared vital, life-saving information as part of the Yellow Dot workshops for Rockville Centre seniors at Sandel Senior Center;
- Hosted community outreach programs such as car seat safety checks for Rockville Centre parents and informational seminars on bullying and cyber-bullying for Rockville Centre students;
- Invited to teach Government to 4th Graders at Covert, Wilson, Hewett and Watson Schools; and
- Stood up for neighbors at a Long Island Railroad and Metropolitan Transportation Authority Forum on services, cleanliness and on-time schedule at the Rockville Centre Library;


