- GPS devices



Items not accepted include:

- large kitchen appliances
- air conditioners
- dehumidifiers
- batteries
- any liquids or powders
- yard equipment
- CDs, DVDs and VHS and cassette tapes
- fluorescent lamps
- smoke detectors
