


**How do you think we should thank our veterans?**

# Thanking Our Veterans



To thank New York's veterans, Assembly Minority Leader Brian Kolb has helped develop and pass legislation to give back to the men and women who have given so much to us by serving in our military. These measures include: The Hire-A-Vet Tax Credit, which rewards businesses that hire unemployed veterans in full-time positions; greater employment protections for military personnel that make it illegal for public employers to eliminate the positions of those absent on military duty; and legislation that prohibits protests at the funerals of fallen veterans.

## 2014 Veterans Agenda

As a society, we have an obligation to fight on behalf of those who fought for our nation. That basic tenet serves as the foundation for measures that Assembly Minority Leader Kolb has introduced and will continue to advocate for in the upcoming Legislative Session:

- **PHOTO IMAGE FEE ELIMINATION** - eliminates the photo image fee for veterans who have their licenses amended with a veteran notation.
- **PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR ACTIVE MILITARY** - Provides men and women actively serving in the military exemptions from real property taxes.
- **SAMPSON VETERANS CEMETERY** - allows Sampson Veterans Cemetery access to federal funds to better provide a dignified place of military burial for veterans.
- **VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE ACT** - extends state benefits now offered to minority- and women-owned business enterprises to honorably-discharged veterans.
- **COLLEGE TUITION FOR FAMILY MEMBERS OF FALLEN MILITARY PERSONNEL** - allows the surviving dependent family members of New York State military personnel who die while on active duty to receive free tuition, room and board at SUNY and CUNY institutions.
