I am happy to report there is some good news for our community from this year's session to improve our infrastructure and help strengthen our economy:

- **\$100 million increase for the CHIPS local highway program** (A.3004-D)
- **\$50 million more for the PAVE NY program** (A.3004-D)
- **54 percent increase for the Extreme Winter Recovery road repair program** (A.3004-D)
- **\$100 million for a new capital program to support the state's scenic byways like the Bethpage State Parkway, Wantagh State Parkway and Meadowbrook State Parkway** (A.3004-D)
