I am excited to share that the bill A1153A has passed in the Assembly and was signed by Governor Hochul in October. This bill relates to unregistered and unlicensed mortgage brokers; and establishes additional penalties against unlicensed or unregistered persons or entities engaging in activities after receiving a cease-and-desist notice. It is important that we prepare our homes and families to work with licensed and registered mortgage brokers. We must work to ensure that the middle class is able to afford to remain middle class while the price of homes, food and basic services continue to rise. I can assure you that I will continue to work hard in creating opportunities to make sure we are not left behind.
