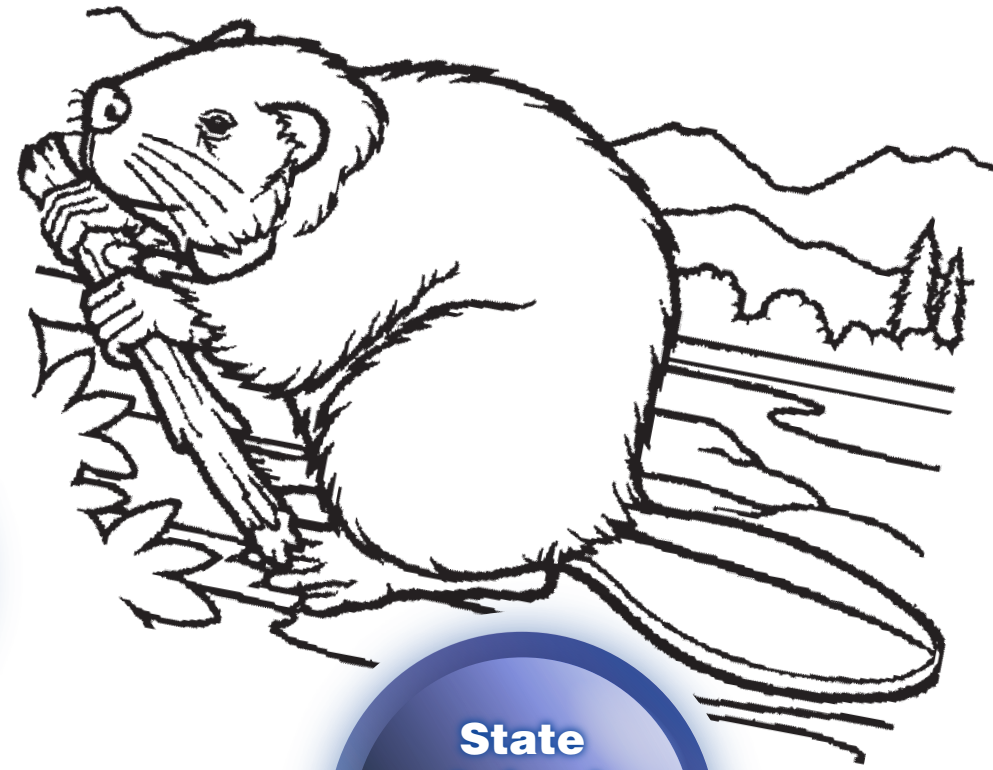
**State Insect**
