Dear Governor Cuomo:

I would like to take this opportunity to strongly encourage you to consider eliminating the disastrous Gap Elimination Adjustment (GEA).

As you are aware, NYS will be paid over \$3 billion dollars as a result of a landmark settlement between the French Bank BNP Paribas and regulators at the State and Federal level due to their repeated violations of U.S. laws and sanctions. This settlement should be invested back into NY State's local schools: first to eliminate the remaining \$1 billion in the GEA for good, and the remaining money to be used toward scheduled school aid increases. More state aid to school districts is critical to keeping our local property taxes down-especially low wealth districts.

I have recently met with a number of School Superintendents to discuss the inequities of aid to rural and low-wealth school districts. These School Districts operate in a fiscally conservative and efficient fashion and their records are living proof of this. I believe each child should have the same opportunities regardless of their family's geographic location. As you know, education is the key to the success for all children and I am sure you would agree, each child in New York State should receive an equal education.
