

## **Thiele Calls for Senate Action on Gasoline Zone Pricing Prohibition After Assembly Approves by a 130-5 Vote**

***Most recent gasoline survey shows South Fork summer prices remain high while regional and national prices have declined***

New York State Assemblyman Fred W. Thiele, Jr. (I, D, WF-Sag Harbor) today called upon the State Senate leadership to approve A.2290, which he sponsors, that would enact the recommendations of the State Attorney General to outlaw the practice of zone pricing of gasoline. Zone pricing would be defined as the establishment of gas prices based on the geographical location of the retail outlet within the relevant geographic market, without regard to the posted terminal price and any additional costs where the effect is to injure competition. The relevant geographic market would be defined as the geographic area which is supplied by the same terminal facility. **On June 17, the State Assembly passed Thiele's bill by a bi-partisan 130-5 margin.** The bill is in the Senate Rules Committee. The bill has been supported by local gasoline retailers and opposed by the major oil companies.

Thiele stated, "It is anticipated that the State Legislature will return to Albany later this year. For the consumers on the South Fork, Westchester, Rochester and other locations impacted by this unfair business practice, it is imperative that the State Senate permit a vote on this bill. The Senate leadership can prove whether they are on the side of consumers or in the pockets of Big Oil."

State Senator Ken LaValle sponsors the bill in the State Senate.

Thiele's most recent gasoline survey for the South Fork taken on July 29, 2014, demonstrates the need for the legislation. Prices remain high on the South Fork averaging over \$4 per gallon while prices have declined on the rest of Long Island and across the nation. Long Island prices are 15 cents less than the South Fork. South Fork prices are also 21 cents above the State average.

The Automobile Association of America (AAA) provides for a regional survey on New York State gasoline prices. However, there is no survey solely for the South Fork. Thiele's survey also includes prices in western Southampton along Montauk Highway. There may be prices that are higher or lower in the region away from Montauk Highway, but the survey reflects the price posted at most stations on our region's main arterials.

Thiele stated, “The average price for East Hampton and Southampton along Montauk Highway excluding Amagansett and Montauk is now \$4.05. The average price for Amagansett and Montauk is \$4.44. A gallon of gas on the North Fork is now about \$3.80. The Long Island average is \$3.90 and the State average is \$3.84.”
