Protecting our planet's future

Assemblyman Thiele passed the New York State Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act (Ch. 106 of 2019), which:

- ✓ **Sets goals to combat climate change**, including:
 - reducing greenhouse gas emissions 85% by 2050
 - producing 70% of the state's electricity from renewable energy systems by 2030
 - producing 100% of the state's electricity without emissions by 2040
- ✓ **Establishes the New York State Climate Action Council** to keep the state on track with its goals
- ✓ **Authorizes renewable energy projects** in public low-income housing statewide
- ✓ **Promotes environmental justice** and sets aside 35% of the overall benefits of spending on clean energy and energy efficiency for projects in disadvantaged neighborhoods
