What is

EPIC?

Last year's budget included \$13 million to help seniors afford their medications.

To join EPIC, a senior must:

Be a New York State resident age 65 or older;

Have an annual income below \$75,000 if single, or \$100,000 if married;

Be enrolled or eligible to enroll in Medicare Part D (no exceptions); and

Not be receiving full Medicaid benefits.
