Reimbursement toward a school resource officer program.<sup>1</sup>



## Day Care Safety Measures

Require the State Education Department to share background check results when applying for employment at child day care centers.<sup>2</sup>



## Know Who Enters Schools

Prohibit sex offenders from voting at a school or facility for children.<sup>3</sup>



## Melanie's Law

Proudly supported "Melanie's Law" to help shield close family members from individuals they feel are a threat to their safety.<sup>4</sup>



## Teal Alert

Address the disappearance of adults aged 18 to 64, including those facing domestic violence threats, with a nationwide broadcast about the individual's disappearance to the public, facilitating prompt assistance.<sup>5</sup>
