# ASSEMBLYWOMAN REBECCA KASSAY IS COMMITTED TO KEEPING THE GREENWAY GREEN

Assemblywoman Kassay has introduced legislation to grant a perpetual conservation easement over Setauket–Port Jefferson Station Greenway so that it may continue to be used for daily walking, biking and passive recreational activities (A.10341). Her bill would protect this natural and scenic corridor, prioritizing conservation efforts and prohibiting development.

## Facts about Setauket–Port Jefferson Station GREENWAY

- » A 3.4-mile corridor that the state Department of Transportation (DOT) acquired in the late 1950s for a potential Route 25A bypass.
- » Despite the bypass concept no longer being viable because of the surrounding residential development, the property is still on the DOT's books as a future roadway.
- » While there are no active plans to create a vehicular bypass in this corridor, the land is not currently protected from future development.
