Assemblyman Phil Ramos: **Standing up for Long Island families**

- **Obtained \$125,000 each for the Brentwood and Central Islip school districts** to provide laptops for students to continue their education remotely
- **Helped distribute sanitizers, gloves, masks and thermometers throughout the community** to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19
- **Helped secure funding for improvements** to local infrastructure, parks and community centers
- **Sponsored legislation that would provide early retirement incentives for teachers** and help school districts to save money (A.7449-A)
- Passed legislation to ensure **COVID-19 contact tracers speak the languages of the communities they serve** (Ch. 294 of 2020)
- **Co-sponsored new laws that increase transparency in law enforcement** and hold bad police officers accountable for their actions
