Assemblyman Jarett Gandolfo is advocating to pass "Laken's Law", which was named in honor of Laken Riley, a University of Georgia student who was killed by an undocumented immigrant earlier this year. Her tragic story underscores the urgent need for stricter measures to help ensure those who break our laws are held accountable, regardless of their immigration status.

When brought to a vote in the Assembly Codes Committee on May 14, 2024, it was rejected by a vote of 14-7 (A.9167).

Laken's Law is common-sense legislation that would protect New Yorkers and ensure criminal migrants are held accountable.²

"Laken's Law would facilitate cooperation between law enforcement and federal immigration authorities to ensure they are aware of non-citizens committing crimes. This type of cooperation could have saved the life of Laken Riley, as the suspect arrested for her murder was previously arrested and released in New York³. We must take steps to address this in our system."

- Restore communication between federal immigration officials (U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement) and law enforcement (A.8033, A.9167).
- Require proper health and safety background checks for all migrants (A.7319-A).
- Stop allowing taxpayer dollars to be spent on free hotel rooms⁴, cell phones⁵, and debit cards⁶ for undocumented migrants.
