- The Environmental Protection Fund (EPF) is funded at \$425 million, an increase of \$25 million from last year. This funding supports conservation, recycling, and climate initiatives across New York State.¹
- The New York Open Water Data Act would require state agencies to create an integrated water data report and make water information more accessible to the public.²
- Providing funding to help homeowners upgrade or replace septic systems to help reduce nitrogen pollution.³
- Updating the Suffolk County Water Quality Restoration Act to change how funds can be used for specific water improvement projects.³
