Funding a better New York

- ✓ **\$340 million** for universal school breakfast and lunch program
- ✓ **\$20 million** to support programs for seniors
- ✓ **\$8 million** for Daniel's Law programs, supporting crisis response efforts
- ✓ **\$3.6 million** for veteran programs
- ✓ Police Benevolent Association (PBA) members earn retirement benefits at 20 years of service, two years earlier
- ✓ Increased pension investments for NYPD Detective Endowment Association, the Sergeants Benevolent Association and Lieutenants Benevolent Association

Uplifting Long Island

- ✓ **\$50 million** to support intermodal infrastructure investments in Suffolk County
- ✓ **\$2 million** to improve the health and ecosystems of Long Island Sound
- ✓ **\$2 million** in additional funding for the Amityville School District
- ✓ **Expanded child tax credits** up to \$1,000 per child under four and up to \$500 per child from 4 through 16 years old
