# Jake's 6-Point Plan to Curb Our Migrant Crisis

Jake Blumencranz supports initiatives to alleviate the burden on communities and prioritize public safety to ensure that New York can continue to be a center of opportunity for all.

- 1. Require the state to review all funds received for humanitarian aid (A.7508)**
- 2. Require New York to register all migrants in order to assist with background checks and monitoring refugees seeking asylum in the state (A.7319)**
- 3. Protect counties and municipalities from being forced to take in migrants from other areas of the state (A.8008)**
- 4. Make sure that funding is not being used to house migrants in schools and daycare centers (A.8013)**
- 5. Allow police to cooperate with the proper legal agencies to make sure our laws are being enforced**
- 6. Call on the federal government to provide assistance to the state and properly address the crisis at the southern border**
