



Here in Nassau County we spend a lot of time on the go. Our local roads and infrastructure matter — not only in terms of safety, but also in terms of commerce. There's never been a more important time for our economy as our state recovers from the pandemic.

I am happy to report there is some good news for our community from this year's session to improve our infrastructure and help strengthen our economy:

- \$100 million increase for the CHIPS local highway program (A.3004-D)
- \$50 million more for the PAVE NY program (A.3004-D)
- 54 percent increase for the Extreme Winter Recovery road repair program (A.3004-D)
- \$100 million for a new capital program to support the state's scenic byways like the Bethpage State Parkway, Wantagh State Parkway and Meadowbrook State Parkway (A.3004-D)







- A bipartisan plan to study and expand broadband internet access was included in the state budget (A.3006-C)
- Workforce development continues to be an important topic of discussion in Albany with our Assembly Minority Conference Task Force on Learning for Work
- My colleagues and I have developed the NY Business Emergency Relief Act to help small employers recover (A.4692)
