COMMITMENT TO CLEAN WATER



- ✓ Ed voted for \$500 million in new funding to bolster our state's historic \$5.5 billion investment in clean water infrastructure.
 - Among other projects, \$5 million will go toward replacing lead drinking water service lines and septic system replacements and upgrades.
- ✓ Ed voted to authorize and extend state investments in clean water projects.²
- ✓ Ed co-sponsored the establishment of the Safe Water and Infrastructure Action Program (SWAP) to repair, replace or rehabilitate local drinking water, stormwater and sanitary sewer systems.³
- ✓ Ed supported giving private companies that provide water services the chance to apply for the same funding as municipalities to ensure equal access to resources for making water cleaner and safer.⁴
- ✓ Ed sponsored a bill to remove the "special franchise" tax on privately owned water-works corporations, providing immediate financial relief for residents burdened by high water bills.⁵
