**Assemblyman Brian Curran has** introduced a proposal that would protect IVF in New York<sup>6</sup> by prohibiting a fertilized human egg outside of the body from being considered a human being. In 2018, Assemblyman Curran cosponsored a proposal that made insurance providers cover IVF in New York.5
