Mammography Van Eligibility:

- ▶ Appointments are required.
- ▶ Must be female and 40 years or older.
- ▶ No mammograms in the past year.
- ▶ Not pregnant or breastfeeding.
- ▶ Never diagnosed with breast cancer.
- ▶ No implants or breast issues, such as breast discharge.
- ▶ If you have health insurance, you will need a prescription from your doctor for a Bilateral Mammogram. If you do not have insurance, the prescription is not necessary.

NOTE: Individuals who do not have health insurance will be processed through the Cancer Services Program of New York, if eligible.
