## COVID-19 RELIEF: Small Business Assistance

**The Small Business Recovery Grant Program** for small and micro businesses and small forprofit independent arts and cultural organizations who experienced a COVID-related financial hardship is **now accepting applications**. The \$800 million program was passed as part of this year's state budget.

**Grants could be used to cover various business costs incurred between March 1, 2020 and April 1, 2021,** including payroll, rent, mortgage, property and school taxes, insurance, utilities, and pandemic-related expenditures that were necessary to protect the health and safety of workers and consumers.

Grant awards will be calculated based on a business's annual gross receipts for 2019 (see below for more information). Grant amounts and calculations are subject to change by Empire State Development.

Annual gross receipts: \$25,000 - \$49,999.99: Award is \$5,000/business

Annual gross receipts: \$50,000 - \$99,999.99: Award is \$10,000/business

Annual gross receipts: \$100,000 - \$500,000: Award is 10% of gross receipts (maximum grant is \$50,000)

## PRIORITY WILL BE GIVEN TO SOCIALLY AND ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED APPLICANTS, INCLUDING:

- minority- and women-owned business enterprises (MWBEs)
- service-disabled veteran-owned businesses and veteran-owned businesses
- businesses located in communities that were economically distressed prior to March 1, 2020
