### **INTRODUCING FLEX TIME LEGISLATION**



I joined New York City Comptroller Scott Stringer as he announced his new report, “Families and Flexibility: Reshaping the Workplace for the 21st Century”. The report calls on New York to adopt “right to request” legislation, providing a formal mechanism for workers and employers to discuss better flexibility in their workplace. I will continue to push for 'right to request' legislation to formalize workplace flexibility practices.

### **ANNOUNCING SAVINGS FOR SENIORS**

Thanks to recent efforts in Albany, I am happy to announce that starting July 1 the income eligibility for the SCRIE (Senior Citizen Rent Increase Exemption) program has been raised to \$50,000! This means that any seniors earning under \$50,000, over the age of 62, living in rent-regulated housing, whose rent is more than a third of their income can have their rent frozen. Additionally, seniors will see an increase in the income eligibility limit for Elderly Pharmaceutical Insurance Coverage (EPIC) to \$75,000 for individuals and \$100,000 for couples. **If you are interested in receiving an application for SCRIE or EPIC, please contact my office at 718-820-0241 or rozicn@assembly.state.ny.us.**
