A bill may be filed by any 150 members of the New York State Assembly and generally, more than one legislator will sponsor a bill. The legislator whose name appears first on the bill is the prime sponsor. Those thereafter are considered cosponsors.

This year, our office sponsored and supported numerous legislative initiatives across key areas, aiming to enhance public welfare, improve education, and strengthen environmental protections. Below is a summary of the bills categorized by major themes and their intended impacts. As of June 2024 here are the prime and co-sponsored bill numbers

• Prime: 39

Cosponsored: 185

Top Anderson Prime Sponsored Bills:

1. A04917D Enacts the School Anti-Violence Education Act. Provides funding for school anti-violence education programs through the omnibus school violence prevention grant program Signed by the Governor

- 2. A4973A Requires the office of victim services to provide notification of potential eligibility for awards following the death of a victim of a crime who died as a direct result of such crime Signed by the Governor
- 3.A9099 Establishes a captive insurance program for commuter vans, black cars, ambulettes and paratransit vehicles, and small school buses pre-arranged for-hire vehicles, and accessible vehicles Awaiting the Governor's Signature
