We have co-sponsored various important pieces of legislation such as:

- A279 New York State Build Public Renewables Act
- A4454 Good Cause Eviction
- A920 All-Electric Buildings Act
- A170 Right To Legal Counsel In Immigration Court Proceedings
- A1280 New York State's Complete Streets Law
- And over 100 more!

I have introduced more than 8 pieces of legislation - 2 of which have already been signed into law!

- Signed into Law! A4137 Clarifies eligibility requirements for the Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) programs in New York.
- Signed into Law! A4015 Clarifies when certain prescription medications may be synchronized for Medicaid patients with chronic illnesses.
- A4895 Requires gas & electric corporations to provide sixty days' notice to customers whenever there is a service rate or charge increase.



Assemblymember Juan Ardila addressed multiple State Agency Officials on Education, Labor, and Social Services during various joint budget hearings.

- A5720 Seeks to create actual affordable housing by using a zip code's AMI in determining affordability levels.
- Awaiting bill # Eliminates rent increase for major capital improvements.
- Awaiting bill # Establishes a green development neighborhood tax exemption.
- And many more!


