As your common-sense voice in Albany, my priority remains the same: fight for policies that help our neighborhood and working families like yours, while opposing silly laws and irrational tax hikes.

This year's budget delivered increased support for our schools, investments to address New York's housing affordability crisis, expanded childcare and early education programs, and additional funding for mental health services and community safety initiatives. Along with our neighbor Assemblyman Simcha Eichenstein, I fought for an important initiative to ensure that New Yorkers can live peacefully: a buffer zone of quiet and safety around houses of worship, schools, and community institutions.

Back home in our district, I am happy to be able to bring more services to our neighbors. This year, I've increased services to include free tax prep for those eligible through Grow NYC, and established my office as an official DSNY e-waste drop-off site. Of course, we continue to provide the services you have come to know and love: our popular free shredding programs, flu shot administration, the monthly MTA Reduced-Fare OMNY van, and so much more.

Your concerns are my concerns. My hardworking team and I are here to help you cut through red tape, connect you with City and State agencies, and get the assistance you deserve.

Legislative Corner

Assemblyman Yeger considers it the highest privilege to write and promote legislation that would translate into real change for New Yorkers, including the following:

A.6025: Allows individuals 75 or older to claim a Jury Duty hardship exemption.

A.2693A: Prohibits New York City from issuing sanitation tickets for trash set out between 3pm on Fridays and 6pm on Saturdays, allowing residents – those leaving town for the weekend and the Sabbath-observant – to place trash out without penalty.

A.9201, A.9213, A.9209 and A.9197: Imposes regulations on e-bike sales (16 years and older), new requirements for helmet wearing (30mph and higher), sufficient front and rear lighting to be included by manufacturers, and to require registration for vehicles capable of travel over 28mph.

A.1425A: Allows those who have difficulty attending in-person hearings for traffic violations the opportunity to do so virtually.

A.6434: Requires commuter rail services to provide benefits and cover healthcare costs for employees who have suffered a physical and/or mental injury caused by a passenger, customer or member of the public during the course of their employment.

A.10192: Increases housing availability by offering incentives for converting office space to housing.

A.8326: Allows caregivers of severely disabled individuals to obtain handicap-marked license plates, instead of a hanging tag, which restricts parking opportunities and can result in driver obstructions.

A.7321A: Would have directed health insurance companies to provide coverage for speech therapy treatment for stuttering. (Passed by the Legislature, but vetoed by the Governor.)



The Assemblyman also lent his support to budget and policy requests for the following important community needs:

- **\$900K:** New York State Professional Fire Fighters Association
- **\$5M:** Met Council
- **\$90M:** Nonpublic School Safety Equipment Grant
- **\$5M:** Holocaust Survivor Initiative Grant
- **\$115M:** STEM + Arts & Music funding for non-public schools

Assemblyman Kalman Yeger and our experienced community office staff can provide you with important services, help you apply for government programs and solve a wide range of problems. Here are just a few of our success stories:

- **A.N.:** Secured an \$5,584 reimbursement from Medicare Part B after he was incorrectly charged for premiums between 2023-26.
- **M.H.:** Assisted in replacing his EZ-Pass tags after they were stolen from his car.
- **B.R.:** Worked with NYCHA management to replace a faulty refrigerator and stove.
- **L.R.:** Restored over a thousand dollars in SCRIE and SCHE that went uncredited by building management.
- **K.Z.:** Worked with OTDA to restore over \$3,000 in miscalculated SSI payments.
- **F.L.:** Removed downed tree after a major storm within 3 hours, instead of the 120 days she was told.
