## Securing a brighter future for Central Brooklyn students

The 2022-23 state budget:

■ Invests **\$31.2 billion** in total education aid, including a **\$1.5 billion** increase in Foundation Aid

■ Invests **\$1.1 billion** in Universal Pre-Kindergarten, which is **\$125 million** above last year

■ Provides **\$53 million** for school mental health programs to help students thrive in the classroom and beyond

■ Provides nearly **\$3 billion** to increase access to quality, affordable child care

■ Increases the funding for public libraries by **\$5.5 million** over last year for a total of **\$99.6 million**
