Greetings --

In March, after the first set of credible allegations of rampant sexual harassment from Governor Cuomo toward employees surfaced, I called for him to resign. He demanded due process. The Attorney General has given him due process and it is damning. Attorney General James' report concluded that he sexually harassed 11 women and groped and touched a number of them. His actions broke both state and federal law. Nine of the women who were harassed worked directly for him, another was a state trooper, and another worked for a company with business before the State. This kind of behavior is reprehensible and cannot be allowed to happen from our State's highest office. That is why I reiterated my demand for his resignation on Tuesday and called on my Assembly colleagues to swiftly impeach the Governor if he did not resign.

On Monday, August 9th, the Assembly Judiciary Committee is meeting to discuss impeachment. The Committee has set a deadline of Friday, August 13th to collect any additional evidence. I have urged my colleagues on the Assembly Judiciary Committee to draft articles of impeachment immediately after the Friday deadline and for the Speaker of the Assembly to call the Assembly into session the following week to vote on those articles.

Our state needs a governor who is fit to run the state. Andrew Cuomo is no longer able to morally or politically execute the duties of Governor of New York State - he must go.

I will keep you updated on all new information and proceedings.
