Alec Brook-Krasny Will Make Our Subways Safe Again

While public transit crime continues to climb¹, New Yorkers are wondering if they will ever feel safe on our subways again. That's why Alec created a simple **5-point plan** to ensure that riders are safe and secure. It would:

NEW YORK ASSEMBLY

- 1** Allow retired law enforcement officers to serve as transit security marshals appointed by local law enforcement or the public transit agency. (A.11054)
- 2** Protect individuals who intervene in emergencies to save lives from legal consequences, as long as their actions are reasonable, proportional, and in good faith. (A.4968)
- 3** Set aside \$100 million in grants to enhance safety infrastructure at public transit facilities throughout the state, with 50 percent of the funds made available to New York City, install barriers on subway platforms and provide adequate resources for law enforcement officers. (A.10916)
- 4** Require violent felony offenses committed by 16- and 17-year-olds, including those committed on public transit, to be tried in Youth Part of the Criminal Court and allow judges to access family court records to ensure that victims of crimes committed by a person under 18 are aware of the final disposition in Family Court cases. (A.4705)
- 5** Prohibit local government actions that would prevent the enforcement of federal immigration laws. (A.5801)
