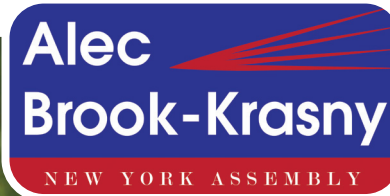
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Alec's 4-Point Affordability Plan

The cost of living is up¹ while working families across southern Brooklyn are dealing with higher rent, groceries and gas². But it doesn't have to be this way.

Alec has a simple, four-point plan that would lower the cost of living for residents and put more money back in your pocket.



- 1. Eliminate sales tax on dozens of everyday items for two years, including (but not limited to) gasoline, personal care products, housekeeping supplies and prepared foods (A.7417)**
- 2. Eliminate taxes on overtime for working New Yorkers (A.8965)**
- 3. Prohibit state departments, offices, agencies and authorities from imposing any fees, surcharges or taxes that have not been approved by the state Legislature (A.295)**
- 4. Increase New York's Earned Income Tax Credit for low- and moderate-income working families and let them receive the money throughout the year instead of waiting until tax season (A.2498)**
