Thousands of protesters poured onto 86th Street and gathered at City Hall to express their opposition to the city's proposal to build a 150-single-man homeless shelter at 2501 86th Street.



WRONG LOCATION

Assemblyman Colton has been leading the fight to make sure that the shelter never opens, for the sake of the people who would reside in it as well as for those who live and work nearby.



PEOPLE'S VOICE

Assemblyman Colton and Council Member Zhuang led a group of volunteers to City Hall and delivered thousands of pages of petition papers with 53,000 signatures to the Deputy Mayor to urge the city to stop building a homeless shelter at 2501 86th Street.

COLTON PROVIDES FOOD ASSISTANCE

Assemblyman Colton has been consistently working with community not-for-profit organizations to help seniors and families-in-need put dinner onto their tables.

Free food distribution events have been held at Marlboro Senior Center, Seth Low Park, Asian Community Center, etc.

COLTON DELIVERS FOOD TO THE DOOR

Assemblyman Colton and Council Member Zhuang personally delivered fruits and vegetables to some apartment buildings after learning that their elevators were out of service.



COLTON FIGHTING FOR SAFER SUBWAYS

Assemblyman Colton has always spoken out and called for more law enforcement officers to be placed on our subways and in the stations.

COLTON'S OFFICE OFFERS METRO CARD SERVICES

On the third of Friday of each month, free MetroCard services are provided at Assemblyman Colton's District Office to seniors (age 65 and above). Services also include Fair Fare MetroCards for low-income families (age 18-64). Appointments are not necessary for either service.

Assemblyman Colton and Council Member Zhuang are proud of and grateful to their volunteers who choose to dedicate themselves to serving their communities and helping their neighbors.



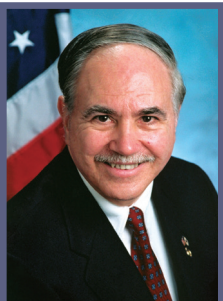
