The 2019-20 state budget:

- Provides \$300 million for the Environmental Protection Fund (EPF) to preserve our natural resources
- Encourages the use of clean and alternative energy by providing \$23 million for clean energy tax credits
- Increases the state's historic investment in clean water to \$3 billion to address emerging contaminants, replace lead drinking water service lines and repair aging water mains and sewer lines
- Lowers the threshold for elevated blood lead levels to protect children from lead poisoning

Assemblywoman Walker secured a big win for the planet!

The budget includes a statewide plastic bag ban to clean up our neighborhoods and waterways.
