New laws lift up all New Yorkers

- Made rent stabilization and rent control permanent and protected tenants from unfair landlord practices and rent hikes (Ch. 36 of 2019)
- Passed commonsense gun safety measures, including keeping guns away from dangerous individuals (Ch. 19 of 2019, A.2684, A.2686-A, A.2690)
- Implemented a historic plan to combat climate change by reducing greenhouse gas emissions, investing in renewable energy and promoting environmental justice (A.8429)
- Banned most single-use plastic bags (Ch. 58 of 2019)
- Made the Jose Peralta New York State DREAM Act a reality so all New Yorkers can achieve their college dreams (Ch. 26 of 2019)
- Passed the Green Light law to allow New Yorkers, regardless of immigration status, to apply for a standard driver's license and keep families safe on the road (Ch. 37 of 2019)
- Enacted critical criminal justice reforms, including eliminating cash bail for most misdemeanors and non-violent felonies, revamping New York's discovery procedures and expunging certain low-level marijuana convictions (Ch. 59 of 2019, A.8420-A)
- Passed comprehensive voting reforms, including early voting, to help ensure every New Yorker's voice is heard (Ch. 2, 3, 4 and 6 of 2019, A.777, A.778)
