MICHAEL'S SOLUTIONS:



REPEAL BAIL REFORM

Fighting to provide judges more discretion and repeal cashless bail laws to help keep repeat offenders off the streets (A.7034).



STOP CLEAN SLATE

Voted NO and strongly opposed to automatically sealing criminal backgrounds with the Clean Slate Act (A.1029-C).



MAKE PAROLE MORE RESTRICTIVE

Support legislation that makes it more difficult for incarcerated individuals to be released into the public (A.5225).



REPEAL RAISE THE AGE

Prevent 16- and 17-year-old offenders who commit serious felonies from escaping criminal liability in family court (A.6409)³.



PROTECT CORRECTION OFFICERS

Enforce stricter penalties for inmates who harass correction officers or correctional facility employees by fraudulently using their names (A.4566).



CATCH PEDOPHILES

Increase the penalty for luring an underage child online (A.5197).
