Assembly Member Seawright is helping keep guns out of the wrong hands

The Assembly passed commonsense measures to stop senseless violence and save lives:

- Established an extreme risk protection order to keep guns away from a person who's a threat to themselves or others (Ch. 19 of 2019)
- Ban bump stocks, which turn firearms into fully automatic machine guns (A.2684)
- Extend the waiting period to 30 days before a gun can be sold to someone who hasn't immediately cleared a background check to ensure a more thorough investigation (A.2690)
- Require safe storage of firearms in a locked depository or render them incapable of being fired if there's a child residing in the home or present (A.2686-A)
