

Get Tested and Boosted Before You Gather For The Holidays!

This site on 79 Street and First Avenue, in front of Saint Monica's Church was offering a PCR saliva test with results returned in 24-48 hours. Seawright and staff encouraged constituents to take part in the no-cost testing.

Free Transportation and In-Home Vaccinations

City residents 65 and older can get free transportation to and from a vaccination appointment. This service is also available for those with disabilities who have no other way to get to a vaccination site.

To schedule free transport by either ambulette or taxi (including wheelchair accessible vehicles), call 877-VAX-4NYC (877-829-4692). This services is available for everyone but if you are younger than 18, you must have your parent or guardian call to book the trip on your behalf.
