Happy Hanukkah to those who are celebrating this weekend! May the celebration of the Festival of Lights bring abundant joy and happiness.

The White House was lit up like a rainbow on December 13 in celebration of President Biden signing the Respect for Marriage Act. This represents an important step forward for our nation. In the Assembly, we continue to support and uplift all New Yorkers. Thank you to our leaders in Washington who are standing up for the sanctity of guaranteed marriage protections.

I announced my sponsorship of legislation to establish a commission to study the impacts of 5G on health and the environment. The community is deprived of knowing about how these sites are selected, and about the health and environmental impacts of clusters of radio frequency radiation. We aim to find out. In the meantime, we have called for a moratorium on the installation of 18 additional Link 5G NYC towers. Community Board 8 also passed a resolution this week calling for a moratorium on the construction and planning of Link 5G poles and devices in the CB8 district.

President Biden Signs Respect For Marriage Act Into Law



This past week on Tuesday, President Joe Biden signed the Respect for Marriage Act into law, guaranteeing federal protections for same-sex and interracial marriage. This comes after the U.S. House of Representatives gave its final approval for the bill with a bipartisan coalition of lawmakers voting in favor of the measure. The President recognized the late Edie Windsor and her spouse Judith Kasen-Windsor, who was at the bill signing, in his speech.

It was only a decade ago that issues such as same-sex marriage were considered a divisive and controversial topic for members of both parties. Since then, however, the support for same-sex marriage has grown to be broadly accepted in American society with polls showing that more than 70% of voters are now in support.

The urgency to codify the Respect for Marriage Act became crystal clear in June after Supreme Court Justice Clarence Thomas, in his concurring opinion overturning federal abortion rights, suggested that the court should consider eliminating other rights, including same-sex marriage and access to contraception. Now, this new law officially repeals the homophobic 1996 Defense of Marriage Act, which defined marriage as between a man and a woman and allowed states to refuse to honor same-sex marriages performed in other states.

Here in New York, the Assembly Majority has long known that love is love, and we were among one of the first states to pass a law legalizing same-sex marriage. We celebrate the signing of this historic piece of legislation and we will continue fighting to further ensure equal rights for all New Yorkers.

Seawright Joins the East 86 Street Association Clean Team




