Assembly Disabilities Chair Rebecca Seawright Rallies to Register New York Voters with **Disabilities**



In 2022, only 50.8% of eligible people with disabilities voted and 14% reported struggling to vote. That's three times more than voters without disabilities. Based on estimates, 2.2 million voters with disabilities faced challenges in 2022.

The coalition of students with disabilities pictured here includes CUNY Votes, the CUNY Office of Disability Programs, The New York Coalition of Students in Higher Education with Disabilities, The CUNY Coalition for Students with Disabilities (CCSD), The New York Public Interest Research Group (NYPIRG), the Viscardi Center, Quality Services for the Autism Community (QSAC), The CUNY Graduate School and University Center, the CUNY Graduate Center, and the NY State Disability Services Council.


