

Henry Viscardi Jr. (1912-2004) was an American disability rights advocate who championed the cause of equality and employment of disabled people in workforce. In 1952, on Eleanor Roosevelt's advice, he founded Abilities, Inc. which has now expanded to the Viscardi Center - a non-profit organization and global leader advocating for the empowerment of people with disabilities.

Sunny is the Viscardi School's service dog. His daily tasks include greeting/goodbyes with students as they start/end the day, motivating students during physical and speech therapy sessions, providing a safe and non-judgmental partner during reading activities, pushing power door buttons, walking with students as a reward, and acting as a social and emotion learning tool to assist children in managing stress and understanding emotions, empathy, goals, and relationships.

All Dog Adoption Fees:

\$75 Dogs 7 months+

\$250 Puppies 6 months & under

\$150 Small Dogs (under 20 lbs.), 7 months+

*NYC residents must purchase \$8.50 - \$34 dog license

\$150 Spay/Neuter deposit may be required





Separating leaf and yard waste, food scraps, and food-soiled paper from trash is mandatory.

Put it in:

• A labeled bin, 55 gallons or less, with a secure lid. Get a free label at nyc.gov/CompostingBinDecal.

REMINDER: Beginning November 12, 2024, buildings with 1-9 residential units, including single-family homes, must set trash out in bins with secure lids (55 gallons or less). More information at nyc.gov/bins.
