Dear Friends and Neighbors,

I am grateful to everyone who took the time to share their thoughts in our last community survey. You told me that public safety, health care, housing affordability, environmental protection, and transportation are among the issues that matter most to our community. Your feedback directly shapes my legislative priorities and advocacy in Albany.

This year, I am proud that several of my bills advanced to strengthen protections for older adults, and all New Yorkers:

- **A.3602 – Family Caregiver Report** (Passed Both Houses): Requires the State Office for the Aging to collect and report data on New York's family caregivers to better inform policies and investments that support the millions of unpaid caregivers who provide essential care to older adults.
- **A.8447 – Elder Financial Exploitation Public Awareness Campaign** (Passed Both Houses): Establishes a statewide public awareness campaign to help older New Yorkers recognize, prevent, and report financial scams and exploitation.
- **A.3601 – Independent Senior Housing Resident Freedom of Choice Act** (Passed the Assembly): Protects the right of older adults living in independent senior housing to choose their own home care and supportive service providers, promoting independence, and aging in place.

Many of you also shared thoughtful comments about the rising cost of housing, access to affordable health care, reckless e-bike operation, pedestrian safety, neighborhood quality of life, and preserving the character of our community. Hearing directly from you helps me better understand the challenges you face and strengthens my work on your behalf.

As I prepare for the next legislative session, I invite you to complete this year's Community Survey. Your voice matters, and your ideas help guide my efforts to make the Upper East Side, Yorkville, and Roosevelt Island safer, more affordable, and an even better place to call home.

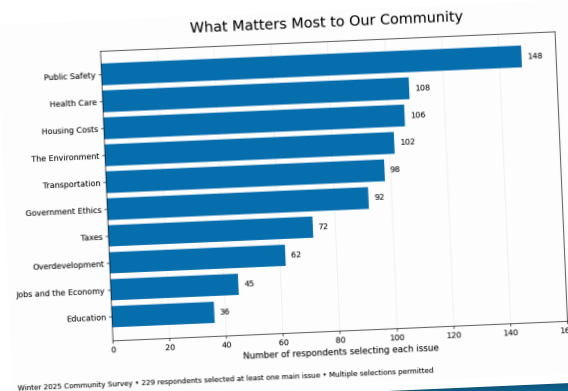
