Claim What's Yours!

The New York State Comptroller's Office is holding billions of dollars in unclaimed funds belonging to individuals, families, businesses, and organizations. If you've ever moved, changed jobs, closed a bank account, or forgotten to cash a check, you could have money waiting for you.

It's free to search, free to file a claim, and there is no deadline to claim your money.

3 Easy Steps

1. Search

Look up your name, business, or even a family member's name in the New York State Comptroller's Unclaimed Funds database.

2. File Your Claim

If you find a match, complete a free online claim in just a few minutes. Most claims require only basic information, though some may require documentation to verify ownership.

3. Get Paid

Once your claim is approved, your payment will be mailed directly to you. Most straightforward claims are processed within about 30 days.

NEED A DOCUMENT NOTARIZED?

If your claim requires notarized forms, Assembly Member Rebecca A. Seawright's office offers FREE Notary Public services to assist constituents. Please note that documents must be signed in the presence of our notary, and valid photo identification is required.
