| 5/3/2024       | Ch. 56 of 2023<br>Part MM<br><a href="#">A.3006-C</a><br><a href="#">S.4006-C</a>  | Expands the MTA’s automated bus lane enforcement camera system and establishes a bus rapid transit demonstration program in New York City. |
| 5/3/2024       | Ch. 57 of 2023<br>Part AA<br><a href="#">S.4007-C</a><br><a href="#">A.3007-C</a>  | Requires hepatitis C screening and third trimester syphilis testing.   |

| 5/15/2024      | Ch. 664 of 2023<br><a href="#">S.6528-A</a><br><a href="#">A.6927-A</a>                      | Requires the secretary of state to promulgate rules and regulations requiring that education and testing for cosmetologists or natural hair stylists include education and testing regarding the provision of services to individuals with all hair types and textures, including, but not limited to, various curl or wave patterns, hair strand thicknesses, and volumes of hair. |
| 5/15/2024      | Ch. 669 of 2023<br><a href="#">S.7387-B</a><br><a href="#">A.7677</a>                        | Establishes the Office of Community Hiring and Workforce Development to facilitate employment opportunities for economically disadvantaged candidates and apprenticeship utilization on public transactions in New York City.   |
| 5/20/2024      | Ch. 58 of 2024<br>Part SS, Subpart B<br><a href="#">A.8808-C</a><br><a href="#">S.8308-C</a> | Provides for the applicability of open meetings and freedom of information laws to state and local authorities.   |
| 5/28/2024      | Ch. 682 of 2023<br><a href="#">S.1783-A</a><br><a href="#">A.372-A</a>                       | Establishes the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual And Transgender, And People Living With HIV Long-Term Care Facility Residents' Bill Of Rights; prohibits a long-term care facility and its staff from discriminating against any resident on the basis of such resident's actual or perceived sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, or HIV status.                              |
