

2025 Impact Map



Unified Water Study: Season 9

Pathogen Indicator Bacteria



INDICATORS

- * Enterococcus
- * E. coli / Total coliforms
- * Fecal coliforms
- Indicator of the presence of fecal material and pathogens from warm-blooded animals
- CAUSES: inadequately treated sewage, runoff, and waste from pets/farm animals/wildlife

2025 Highlights

- * 745 samples collected & analyzed
- * 12 weeks of regular monitoring
- * 16 volunteers
- 66 sites



From 2022 to 2024:

- \$208,000,000
- o 76 projects
- CWIA, EPF and Environmental Bond Act









2024: \$462,500 for stormwater and erosion management at Stony Brook Harbor

2023: \$1,130,000 for stormwater infrastructure upgrades in New Rochelle

2023: \$15,000,000 for combined sewer overflow upgrades in the Bronx

2022: \$749,976 for pollution filtration & shoreline stabilization in Udalls Cove, Queens


