Funding Supports Updating Water Infrastructure, Combatting Harmful Algal Blooms, Protecting Drinking Water, Increasing Flood Resilience, and Treating Contamination from Landfills.   - Grant categories in WQIP program: Wastewater Treatment Improvement , Nonagricultural Nonpoint Source Abatement and Control, Vacuum Trucks in Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Areas, Land Acquisition for Source Water Protection, Salt Storage and Road Salt Reduction, Dam Safety

Repair/Rehabilitation and Removal, Aquatic Connectivity, Marine District Habitat Restoration, Fish and Wildlife Habitat Restoration and Enhancement Landfill Leachate Treatment.
