# Assemblymember Chris Burdick

## Passes laws to keep our communities safe from gun violence

- **Updates conceal and carry requirements and requires firearm training courses for applicants**, while also identifying sensitive locations where it is prohibited to carry a concealed weapon. (Ch. 371 of 2022)
- **Strengthens New York's Red Flag Law** (Ch. 208 of 2022)
- **Raises the age to purchase a semiautomatic rifle to 21** and requires a license to purchase (Ch. 212 of 2022)
- **Eliminates the grandfathering of high-capacity magazines** (Ch. 209 of 2022)
- **Bans bulletproof vests** for all except people in eligible professions (Ch. 210 of 2022)
- Implements enhanced **safety and security measures at gun stores** (Ch. 207 of 2022)
- Requires social media companies to give users an **easily accessible way to report hateful content** (Ch. 204 of 2022)
- Creates a new **task force on social media and violent extremism** (Ch. 213 of 2022)
- **Makes it a crime to threaten mass harm** (Ch. 206 of 2022)
