Hold Dangerous Individuals Accountable

Support common-sense reforms to fix New York's cashless bail and discovery laws¹ and empower judges to keep dangerous individuals behind bars.²

Combat Opioid Epidemic

Support individuals in recovery by establishing a task force to develop best-practice standards for certified recovery residences³, while increasing penalties for drug dealers whose illegal sales result in fatal overdoses⁴.

Support Law Enforcement

Fund new technology and equipment for law enforcement to ensure they have the tools to keep our communities safe.

Protect Children

Working to expand life sentences for sex crimes against children.⁵ Fighting to require lifetime parole supervision for violent sexual offenders and provide funding for school resource officers to improve school safety.⁶
