New Laws for August 2023

New state laws go into effect every month. Here is a list of new laws going into effect in August:

Effective Date	Chapter	Summary
8/1/2023	Ch. 129 of 2023 A.1395-C S.1213-B	Provides access to medication abortion prescription drugs at SUNY and CUNY campuses by employing or contracting with individuals authorized to prescribe such drugs, or by providing referrals.
8/30/2023	Ch. 9 of 2023, Â§2 A.613 S.1354	Requires the Office of Mental Health to provide monthly status reports of community investments and the impact on inpatient census to the Legislature as well as post on its website.
8/31/2023	Ch. 55 of 2023, Part H, Â§ 4 A.3005-C S.4005-C	Authorizes the payment of a training stipend to volunteer firefighters by a volunteer fire company and the Office of Fire Prevention and Control.
8/31/2023	Ch. 56 of 2023 Part LL A.3006-C S.4006-C	Authorizes the Department of Corrections to use body scanners for employees at state correctional facilities, visitors, and incarcerated individuals.
