New Laws for June 2024



New state laws go into effect every month. Here is a list of laws going into effect in June 2024:

Effective Date	Chapter	Summary
6/1/2024	Ch. 743 of 2023 A.5985-A S.4401-A Ch. 97 of 2024 S.8024 A.8512	Requires the Department of Health to develop, maintain, and distribute to practicing and licensed physicians in the state a resource library related to continuing medical education and training opportunities regarding nutrition.
6/1/2024	Ch. 58 of 2024 Part PP A.8808-C S.8308-C	Establishes a sales tax exemption for residential energy storage systems equipment.
6/1/2024	Ch. 59 of 2024 Part L, § 1, 2 S.8309-B A.8809-B	Provides for the taxation of adult-use cannabis products where books and records are not provided or are determined to be insufficient.
6/1/2024	Ch. 59 of 2024 Part T S.8309-B A.8809-B	Lowers the excise tax rate on medical cannabis and provides for the allocation of moneys of the medical cannabis trust fund.
6/5/2024	Ch. 686 of 2023 A.5604 S.5397 Ch. 71 of 2024 S.8051 A.8490	Allows mobile crisis response staff members to use a green light on their motor vehicle when engaging in an emergency operation.

6/7/2024	Ch. 364 of 2023 S.2946-B A.75-B	Enacts the 9/11 Notice Act, which provides for notice to past and present employees of eligibility for the September Eleventh Victim Compensation Fund and the World Trade Center Health Program.
6/19/2024	Ch. 734 of 2023 A.266-A S.3114-A Ch. 42 of 2024 A.8546 S.8032	Requires state agencies to conform their websites to the most current version of the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines adopted by the World Wide Web Consortium for accessibility.
6/19/2024	Ch.737 of 2023 A.1368-A S.406-A Ch. 99 of 2024 S.8043 A.8509	Authorizes utility corporations, cellular phone companies, telegraph and telephone corporations, and cable television corporations to provide notice of bills to third parties at the request of the customer.
6/19/2024	Ch.738 of 2023 A.1707-A S.599-A	Requires certain manufacturers of prescription drugs to notify the superintendent of any proposed increase of the wholesale acquisition cost of such prescription drugs.

6/19/2024	<p>Ch. 770 of 2023</p> <p>S.7211</p> <p>A.7218</p> <p>Ch. 49 of 2024</p> <p>S.8003</p> <p>A.8520</p>	Provides for the reporting and resolution of issues at residential health care facilities; requires long-term care ombudsmen to receive training in cultural competency and diversity and establishes an outreach and awareness program to promote and recruit long-term care ombudsmen.

6/19/2024	<p>Ch. 56 of 2024</p> <p>Part J</p> <p>S.8306-C</p> <p>A.8806-C</p>	<p>Grants 30 minutes paid break time for an employee to express breast milk.</p>
6/19/2024	<p>Ch. 56 of 2024</p> <p>Part OO</p> <p>S.8306-C</p> <p>A.8806-C</p>	<p>Enacts Sammy's Law, which authorizes New York City to establish speed limits below 20 miles per hour.</p>
6/23/2024	<p>Ch. 758 of 2022</p> <p>A.10186</p> <p>S.8805</p> <p>Ch. 29 of 2023</p> <p>§§ 1-5</p> <p>A.973</p> <p>S.839</p>	<p>Requires space for donate life registration on forms used for enrollment, renewal, disclosures and related health insurance policy transactions and when setting up an online member service portal with an insurer.</p>
6/24/2024	<p>Ch. 230 of 2022</p> <p>§§ 2-3</p> <p>S.9449</p> <p>A.6008-E</p>	<p>Provides for a process for eligible mental health counselors, marriage and family therapists, and psychoanalysts to apply to SED for the issuance of a privilege to diagnose and develop assessment-based treatment plans.</p>

6/30/2024	Ch. 58 of 2024 Part L A.8808-C S.8308-C	Enacts the Waterfront Commission Act to regulate the occupations of longshore workers, stevedores, pier superintendents, hiring agents and security officers to preserve the rights of such workers and the economic stability of the port of New York district.
